

Meggendorfer Prizes

At the biennial conference of the Society, the Meggendorfer Prize is awarded for outstanding paper engineering to the artist/paper engineer who has produced the most outstanding commercially published pop-up or movable book issued in the two preceding years. Beginning in 2014, the Society began awarding two additional prizes: the Meggendorfer Prize to the creator of the best pop-up or movable artist book and another to the Outstanding Emerging Paper Engineer.
